Transmission of Non-Legacy Classics and Renewal of Culture:

A Survey and Analysis of Woodblock Prints in Zhuxian Town

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Abstract

Henan Zhuxianzhen woodblock prints is the originator of Chinese woodblock prints and a treasure of Chinese classic traditional culture, which not only carries the reverence and praise of generations of Kaifeng craftsmen for woodblock prints, but also carries the deep historical memory and rich cultural connotation of the Chinese nation. However, the protection and inheritance of non-heritage work is not an overnight thing, through the publicity and promotion of Zhuxianzhen woodblock prints, can enhance public awareness and understanding of non-heritage culture, and improve the cultural consciousness and cultural self-confidence of the whole society. This paper will mainly focus on the inheritance and protection of Zhuxianzhen woodblock prints and the current situation of the cultural development of the market situation of the two aspects of the analysis and research, and at the same time for the problems existing at this stage of the proposal has a strong focus on the resolution of the measures.

Therefore, in-depth analysis and research on the historical background, artistic characteristics, inheritance value, market development and other issues of woodblock prints in Zhuxianzhen is of great significance to promote the protection and development of traditional culture.

With the increasing attention of the state to the protection of intangible cultural heritage, the woodblock prints of Zhuxianzhen, Henan Province, as an intangible heritage project has also received more attention and protection. In addition, Zhuxianzhen New Year Paintings are also different in the choice of themes, reflecting more cultural characteristics and folk beliefs of the Central Plains. Through comparative analysis, it can be found that Zhuxianzhen woodblock prints occupy an irreplaceable and important position in the art of Chinese New Year paintings.

The production of Zhuxianzhen woodblock prints requires the use of high-quality wood and paper and other raw materials, the prices of which are greatly affected by market fluctuations. In recent years, with the implementation of environmental protection policies and the reduction of raw material resources, the cost of raw materials has been rising, which has brought great pressure to the production of New Year paintings.

6.1.4 Insufficient Technological Innovation

In today's rapidly changing technology, the production technology of woodblock prints in Zhuxian Town is relatively lagging behind. Although the traditional production process is exquisite, it is difficult to meet the demands of the modern market in terms of efficiency and quality. The lack of technological innovation has limited the development space of the New Year's Paintings industry. In modern society, consumers have higher and higher demands for product diversity and personalization, while Zhu Xianzhen woodblock prints are obviously unable to meet the market demand in this regard.

6.2 Specific Solutions to the Problems

6.2.1 Reinforcement of Skill Training

In order to solve the problem of difficult inheritance of skills, the training of skills can be strengthened. Through the opening of skills training courses, experienced veteran artists can be invited as lecturers to teach traditional skills to the younger generation. At the same time, it can cooperate with educational institutions to incorporate Zhuxianzhen woodblock print technique into the vocational education system and cultivate more professionals.

6.2.2 Expand Market Channels

In view of the fast-changing market demand, we can actively expand market channels. Through the combination of online publicity and offline physical sales, the New Year painting products can be promoted to a wider group of consumers. At the same time, it can develop cultural and creative derivatives of New Year's paintings, as well as cooperate and co-brand with famous brands to meet the needs of different consumers.

6.2.3 Optimizing Raw Material Procurement While Introducing Modern Technology

In order to reduce the cost of raw materials, raw material procurement can be optimized. Establish long-term cooperative relationships with suppliers to ensure stable supply and quality of raw materials. At the same time, the use of environmentally friendly and renewable alternative materials can be explored, which not only meets the requirements of environmental protection policies, but also reduces costs. In order to enhance technological innovation, modern technology can be actively introduced. For example, digital technology can be used to record and preserve traditional skills to facilitate inheritance and learning. At the same time, the use of modern printing technology, digital design software and other tools can be explored to improve production efficiency and product quality.
